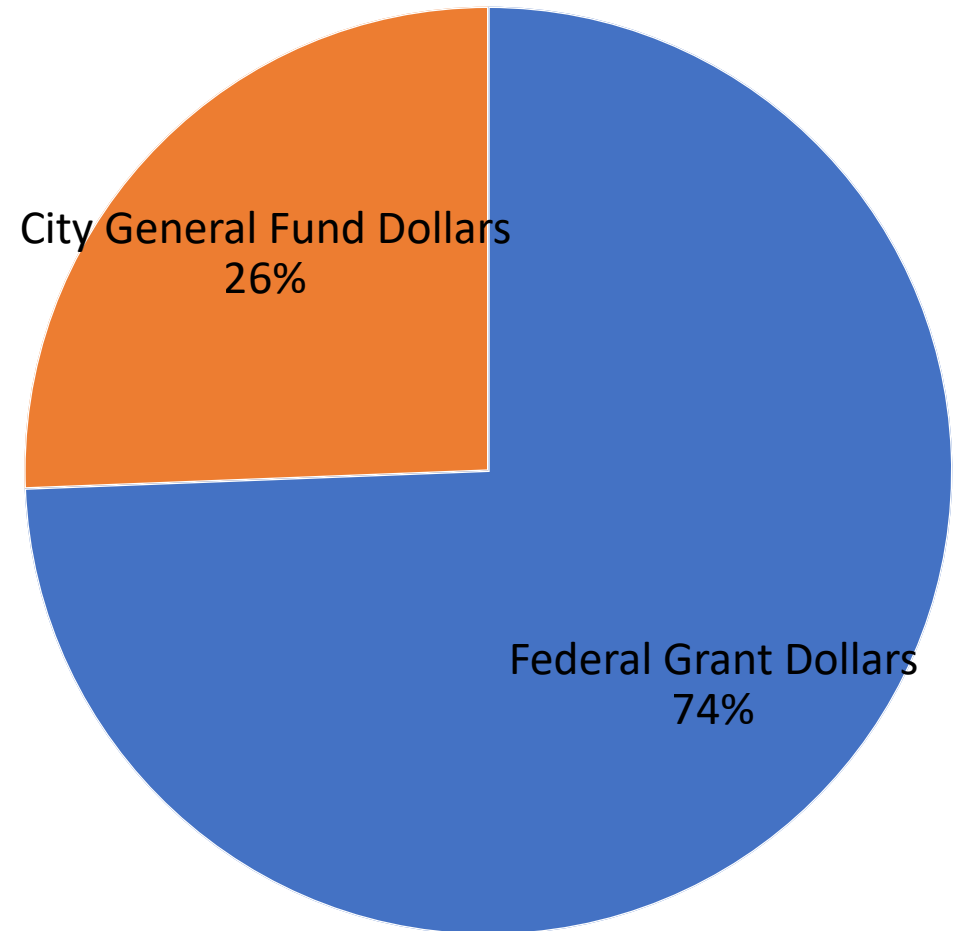

Phase 1: Needs Assessment	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Training assessment focus group moderator guide and interview instruments (as appropriate) • Training assessment report (certificate and possible future training needs ongoing needs)
Phase 2: Program Design and Development	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Program curriculum and learning modules • Program overview or “fact sheet” (with specifics on program format, structure, learning modules, etc.) • Finalized list of key program faculty/instructors
Phase 3: Program Pre-Launch	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Program marketing and promotional content/materials • Program application/referral content/materials • Program instructional content/materials
Phase 4: Program Implementation	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Deliver 1 cohort of the Community Violence Intervention program for 20 participants • Included in the program delivery are 10 days of in-person instruction, textbooks, course materials, access to online learning management system and electronic resources, coffee breaks and lunch for participants, certificate of completion, digital badge verifying completion, and a graduation lunch
