## SURRENDER OF POSSESSION AGREEMENT

THIS SURRENDER OF POSSESSION AGREEMENT (the "Agreement") is made as of the Effective Date (defined below), by and between Mayor and City Council of Baltimore, a municipal corporation of the State of Maryland, acting by and through its Departments of Recreation & Parks ("Department") (together, the "City"), and The Baltimore City Board of School Commissioners, which operates a system of public schools commonly known as the Baltimore City Public School System or Baltimore City Public Schools ("City Schools"), ("Board").

## <u>RECITALS</u>

- A. In 1997 the Maryland General Assembly amended Section 4-303 of the Education Article, Maryland Code Annotated, to establish the Board. Prior to such amendment the City operated the Baltimore City Public School System and owned and continues to hold title to school property used in connection with the Board's educational mission.
- B. Prior to the establishment of the Board, the City erected and operated certain Recreation Centers on its school properties to provide after school recreational opportunities to the School System's student body and the general public. In connection therewith the City constructed the following Recreation Centers all located in Baltimore City, Maryland as follows: (i) Gardenville Recreation Center located on the premises of Hazelwood Elementary School located at 4517 Hazelwood Avenue, 21206; (ii) Liberty Recreation Center located on the premises of Liberty Elementary School located at 3901 Maine Avenue, 21207; (iii) Leith Walk Recreation Center located on the premises of Leith Walk Elementary School located at 1235 Sherwood Avenue, 21239, (iv) Barclay Recreation Center located on the premises of Barclay Elementary and Middle School located at 2900 Barclay Street, 21218; and (V) Callaway Recreation Center located on the premises of Callaway Elementary School located at 3701 Fernhill Avenue, 21215, (Collectively "Rec Centers").
- C. Although the City, pursuant to Section 4-114 of the Education Article, Maryland Code Annotated, has granted full possession of its school property to the Board, the City has maintained possession of the Rec Centers and continues to maintain and operate them.
- D. The City has determined it no longer wishes to operate and maintain the Rec Centers and wishes to surrender to the Board its possession of the Rec Centers and the Board is willing to accept such surrender and thereafter maintain the Rec Centers.
