Dear Director Rodriguez-Lima;

On March 27, 2024, you submitted an emergency gift solicitation waiver petition to the Baltimore City Board of Ethics ("Board"), requesting expedited review and approval pursuant to the 2023 Agreement between the Board and the Office of Emergency Management.

Today, the Board **approved** a PROVISIONAL WAIVER for the Key Bridge Emergency Fund.

That provisional waiver is

- (a) contingent upon **approval by the Board of Estimates** and
- (b) conditioned on the **development and implementation of policies and regulations by the Baltimore City Law Dept. regarding any disbursement** of the funds collected.

The Board may lift the provisional status of this waiver after being provided with a brief presentation of the goals, means, and other provisions of this campaign during its public meeting on April 9, 2024.
