## BACKGROUND/EXPLANATION:

This is an emergency response application for charitable solicitation request from the Mayor's Office of Immigrant and Cultural Affairs (MIMA) by way of the Baltimore Civic Fund (BCF). All contributions will be used to support the construction crew victim's immediate families with costs related to repatriation, funeral expenses, humanitarian paroles services, medical costs, food, and other much needed aid.
